## **Exemplar Education – Brexit Statement**

As a responsible service provider and user of personal data, we need to ensure that we are prepared for a No Deal Brexit.

We use a number of third party software providers.

Our learning systems are hosted in the USA by a UK company and operate under the EU-U.S. Privacy Shield. This ensures compliance with the UK Protection Act 2018 and will not change post Brexit.

Data transmission is via Amazon Web Services, which is certified under the EU:US Privacy Shield and will not change post Brexit.

Our systems also use other providers of services in the cloud, e.g., Amazon & Microsoft, all of whom have very high-quality security on their hosting systems and are compliant with both GDPR and the UK Data Protection Act 2018. Some of these currently store data within the EU.

We are currently in dialogue with our suppliers to establish whether there are any issues we need to address to ensure continued compliance with The UK Data Protection Act in the event of No Deal Brexit and whether there are any actions we need to take to enable that.

But until the terms of any Brexit deal are published, it will not be clear if there are any specific issues that need to be addressed.

We are keeping the situation under review as the negotiations progress and any further information will be posted here, as soon as it is available.
